What does it mean to be 360° disciples of Jesus? It means this: by the grace of God we turn 180° away from the world toward the Lord Jesus, in whom we experience forgiveness, rebirth, healing and loving intimacy. Through the power of the Holy Spirit we turn 180° back into the world to be His witnesses, thereby bringing us "full circle" as 360° disciples.

Hebrews 10 speaks of entering the Most Holy Place of worship, which is, "inside the veil." In the presence of Jesus we experience the intimacy of prayer and worship.

Hebrews 13 speaks of going with our crucified and risen Lord "outside the gate," that is, into the world, to give testimony of God's great love. Through the power of the Holy Spirit the cycle repeats: we regularly experience intimacy with Him followed by service with Him.

We hope this theme resonates with our hearts as together we seek to become more faithful servants of Jesus to the world He loves.
